### **Baby Shower Breakfast Eggs**

If you went to Lion Julie Lee and son, Charlie's, baby shower then you remember the tasty sausage and egg dish. By popular request, here's the recipe. By the way, not only did we get to meet baby Charlie but also baby Matthew Lundstrom, accompanied by proud mom, Lion Julie Lundstrom and extra-proud grandma, Lion Sue Hinck. Both Julies really look great! Congratulations again on your beautiful boys.

2 pkgs. Jimmy Dean regular sausage (1 of the pkgs can be sage seasoned sausage)  
10 eggs  
1 tsp salt  
7 slices bread, crusts removed, cubed  
1 ½ C. grated med. Cheddar cheese

3 C. milk  
1 tsp dry mustard

Brown sausage, drain. Separately, beat eggs in lg bowl; add milk, salt, mustard, & bread. Stir in cheese and sausage. Put in well-greased 9x10 pan. (I think Shar used a 9x13). Refrigerate overnight. Bake at 350\* for 45 min. or until eggs test done in the middle. Shar says it usually takes about 1hr. Let set a short time before serving. Serves 8-10.
